This, in fact, is what you were

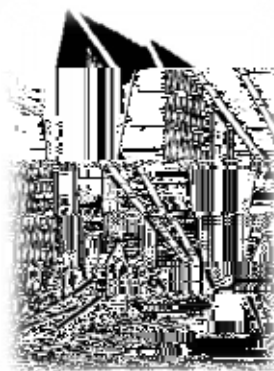
COMMUNION ANTIPHON:
